#### **MEETINGS**

The Bonefish Base of USSVI currently conducts its meetings on the 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of every month. The base currently meets at Zacatecas Cafe located at 3767 Iowa Avenue #4549, Riverside, California 92507, 951-683-3939.

The exception to this is for the months of November and December. Since the 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday meeting generally conflicts with the holidays, the two meetings are combined into one, which is held in early December, and is our holiday celebration.

Meeting times are 12 noon to about 2pm, and include lunch. Members and guests are encouraged to arrive around 11:30 to take care of necessities before the meeting can start at noon. Meetings generally include a base business meeting and service, and a speaker/program of interest to all. Afterwards lunch is served.

At times, opportunities arise of special interest that may prompt a change in meeting place for a special event or location. These changes are listed on the base website and announced in advance so everyone is aware of them.

A couple of meetings have a special emphasis in getting together. January is when we swear in new board members every two years. It is also the time when we recognize and honor members for their special anniversaries, such as Holland Club, longevity and special awards. May is the time we honor and remember our members who are on Eternal Patrol

#### **ACTIVITIES WE PARTICIPATE IN:**

MARCH – Martin Luther King High School in Riverside sponsors a program called "King High Remembers". We encourage all of our members to participate. The program consists of the Junior Class history students interviewing veterans about their military service.

APRIL – Rancho Cucamonga High School sponsors a program similar to King High Remembers. Again, we encourage our members to participate and share their military experience.

MAY – Corona High School sponsors a program similar to King High Remembers. Again, we encourage our members to participate and share their military experience.

JULY – We participate in various July 4<sup>th</sup> parades with our float of the USS Bonefish SS-223. Depending on scheduling we have participated in Corona, Redlands, or Huntington Beach.

NOVEMBER – We participate in various Veteran's Day events, mostly parades with our float. Again, depending on scheduling we have participated in Riverside, Redlands, Flabob Airport, Murrieta or Huntington Beach.

Patriot High School sponsors a program similar to King High Remembers. Again, we encourage our members to participate and share their military experience.

**DECEMBER** – Our November and December meetings are combined into one meeting around the first Saturday in December, short on business and more about the holidays.

In December 2019, we held our first Pearl Harbor Remembrance Service at Riverside National Cemetery, and hope to continue it as Covid restrictions are eased.

When possible, we work with the other USSVI bases in Southern California for events or activities, as we are the only base in the Inland Empire.

We have participated in the "Kap(SS) for Kid(SS)" program. Members are encouraged to participate in a visit to a local hospital or child center for ill or handicapped children. We give the children certificates making them "Honorary Submariners" along with a cap for them to wear with dolphins on their hats.

We have participated in other events in the past that may not be active any longer. We are always looking for other activities that may afford us the opportunity to participate, making sure it fits our creed.

We see these events and activities as a way to honor and remember all submarine veterans, past, present, and future, as is stated on the Memorial Plaque we installed at Riverside National Cemetery in 2014. We also see all of these as a way to meet potential members for the base so that we may continue to be a vibrant voice in our communities.
